


# Identification guide for 1984-1997 Dutchwest Stoves

# Dutchwest

There is a wide variety of Dutchwest stoves. This guide will help you identify stoves built between 1984-1997. Sometimes two or three model numbers appear on the identification plate; the model number for a stove may not be checked off. To start on identifying a stove, measure across the top plate, including where it overhangs the sides. Then, compare features with this guide to determine which stove you have. Note that measurements are approximate.

The convection air outlet is a horizontal slot with a brass bar.






## Single main front door

If X = 22", stove is model 2460 (small convection)

If X = 26", stove is model 2461 (large convection)

If X = 28", stove is model 2462 (extra-large convection)



1990-1993 units

#### Two front doors, side by side


If X = 22", stove is model 2181 (small convection)

If X = 26", stove is model 2183 (large convection)

If X = 28", stove is model 2184 (extra-large convex (The extra-large has arched windows)



# 1984-86, and 1986-1990 Dutchwest Convection stoves



If X = 22", stove is model FA224CCL (small convection).


If X = 26", stove is model FA264CCL (large convection).


Units built in 1984-86 have no air inlet over the side door;

Units built in 1986-90 have an air inlet over the side door.


If X = 26" and the side-load door is on the right-hand side (as you face the stove), the stove is model FA264CCL-R


If X = 28\*, stove is model FA288CCL (extra-large convection), 1985-90 versions of model FA288CCL have arched windows.






